## Four operational tiers:

1. Developing expertise
2. Disseminating expertise
3. Prevention / promotion
4. Collaboration

## Four tiers of training to disseminate expertise:

1. Facility-targeted
2. Mainstreaming
3. Peer education
4. Master classes





**Facility-targeted training** includes minimum of 6 hours with package of ongoing technical support, mentoring, consultation and referral – already piloted in several clinics in Winelands area

**Mainstreaming** piloted and CPD-approved

**Peer educator** training needs completion of 5 modules over 6 months:



# HEALTH 4 MEN

Complete four compulsory modules:

1. Intro to male sexualities
2. Essentials of HIV and STIs
3. Tools of the trade
4. Basic counselling / ethics

PLUS one elective:

- Anal, prostate, testicular health
- Recreational substances



## Other:

1. UCT 4<sup>th</sup> year medical students, Dept. Medicine
2. UCT 5<sup>th</sup> year elective student placement, Dept. Public Health
3. Host post-grad students for operational research (local and international) Complete four compulsory modules
4. Training of DOH pharmacy assistants
5. Training of trainers and counselling staff at ATICC
6. Training of staff for Dept. Correctional Services
7. Training staff of various organisations, including Desmond Tutu HIV Foundation and the Medical Research Council
